# **Description**

### **Directions for Use**

Important: Use in a well-ventilated area

- 1. Shake can well before use.
- 2. Surfaces should be clean, dry and free from dust and grease.
- 3. Spray adhesive from 6" 8" away onto one or both surfaces
- 4. For one-way application let adhesive dry for 30 seconds until tacky, and then press into position.
- 5. For two-way application, spray both surfaces and allow to dry for 2-5 minutes before bonding.
- 6. For temporary bonding, spray one surface and allow to dry for 2-5 minutes before bonding.
- 7. To prevent spray nozzle from blocking, at the end of each period of use, turn the can upside down and press nozzle until spray is clear of adhesive.
- 8. Excess adhesive can be removed with a solvent cleaner or white spirit.

### **Precaution**

- 1. Important: Do not allow the product to freeze
- 2. Protect from extremes of temperature in a controlled environment between 15 and 35°C, and away from direct sunlight.
- 3. Do not stand on a cold concrete floor.
- 4. Low temperatures can result in irreparable separation of the adhesive.
- 5. Stored under the correct conditions, in original, unopened containers, the product will have a shelf life of up to 12 months.
